EJL Wireless Research Reports Global BTS Transceiver Market Grew 19.8% in 2005

Redwood City, CA, June 7, 2006: The global base transmitting station (BTS) transceiver (TRx) market grew by 19.8% in units in 2005, a decline from 49.8% growth in 2004, according to the latest report from EJL Wireless Research titled "Global BTS Transceiver Market Analysis and Forecast, 2005-2010." "The transceiver market continued to show growth in 2005 but the growth rate had already hit a peak in 2004," says founder and President, Earl Lum. The report provides a unique perspective on the global shipments and demand for TRx equipment covering all major OEMs including Alcatel, Ericsson, Huawei Technologies, Lucent Technologies, Motorola, Nokia, Nortel Networks, Siemens and ZTE. "Ericsson maintained its top position but its growth rate significantly lagged the overall market in 2005 and the company was second in UMTS TRx shipments to Nokia" says Lum.

While the market continues to see growth through 2006, the report cites that the BTS TRx market may begin to experience some softness beginning in 2007. "Similar to the BTS market, the TRx market has been driven largely by GSM technology. We believe that GSM will begin to show softness in demand by 2007 and this will lead to a decline in overall TRx shipments," says Lum.
